Monday 1st December—The O Antiphons

The O Antiphons are ancient prayers that voice the promises of justice and peace anticipated in Christ's coming. Today we will explore the seven O Antiphons in music and word, take their cry for justice as our own prayer for today, and discover their hidden Advent message of hope.
